Meet us Saturday morning to discuss the book club pick for October! This month's book is Flowers of the Killer Moon by David Grann:

In the 1920s, the wealthiest people per capita were the Osage Nation in Oklahoma due to oil discoveries. They enjoyed luxurious lifestyles, but then, members began to be mysteriously murdered. Mollie Burkhart's family was targeted, with relatives shot and poisoned, leading to a rise in suspicious deaths and the murders of those investigating.

As the situation worsened, the newly formed FBI, led by J. Edgar Hoover, assigned former Texas Ranger Tom White to the case. He assembled an undercover team, including a Native American agent, to help the Osage uncover a chilling conspiracy.

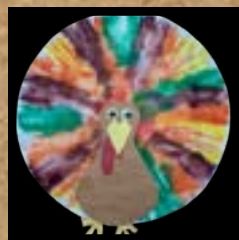

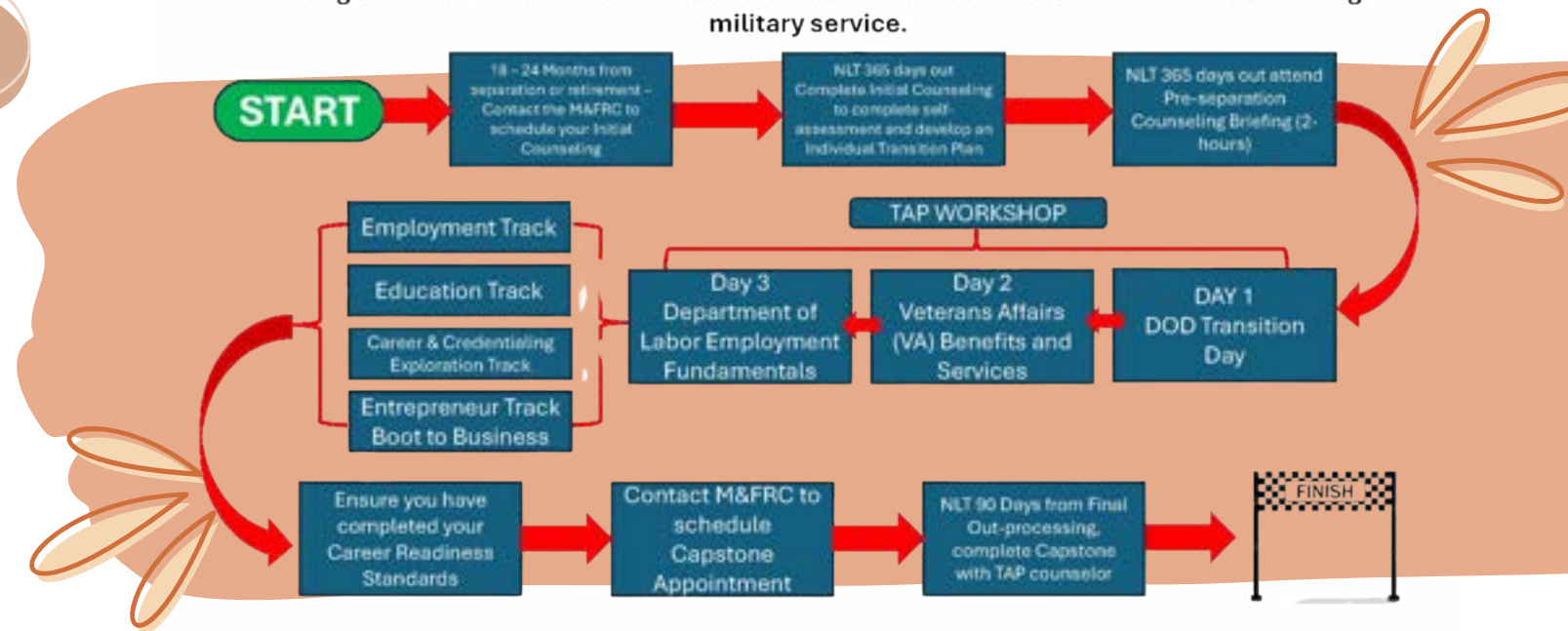

The Whiteman Transition Assistance Program (TAP, not TAPS) team is ready to help you comply with these congressional mandates! Regardless of the requirement, this program is designed to help relieve the stress of getting a civilian job, going back to school, starting your own business, or help you decide what path to pursue. TAP can also help you make an educated decision if you are unsure about staying in or getting out. Call the M&FRC to schedule your first appointment.
